Councilwoman Hahn Brings Affordable Senior Housing to Wilmington

Councilwoman Janice Hahn today advanced the final phase of construction in the Dana Strand housing development, which will include 100 units of affordable senior housing at the Wilmington-based property.

The Councilwoman's action has given the Los Angeles Housing Department (LAHD) the necessary authority to issue housing revenue bonds in the amount of \$14.4 million, the amount needed to complete the project. Previous phases of the project have included the construction of low-income apartments in 2007, along with middle-income town homes built last year.

"Los Angeles is always in need of affordable housing, particularly for seniors, and this project will really help fulfill that need. It will also be a great addition to the ongoing improvements we've been making throughout the Wilmington community," said Councilwoman Hahn.

Construction is due to commence in spring of 2010.
